



Crowfoot Arena Spectator Policy U9-U18

As of October 9th, 2020, Crowfoot Arena will allow spectators for games only. Please follow these guidelines. Teams that do not follow the guidelines below will be asked to leave the facility and future ice times may be revoked;

- 1 Family member per player will be permitted in the stands for games.
- Anyone found not abiding by these rules may cause a delay in the game until the issue is resolved
- Managers and Coaches on the team roster do not count as a spectator – they are part of the Cohort.
- No spectators allowed for practices.
- Team managers are required to keep attendance lists for each game. Please keep these for 20 days in case they are required by AHS for contact tracing purposes.
- Face coverings are mandatory in the common areas of the facility
- 10 spectators maximum per stand. Seating will be marked with an “X”. Sit with the spectators from your team. The upstairs catwalk viewing area is open to 27 spectators maximum – standing on the “X”
- No standing at or around the glass or in the lobby – viewing is from the stands or upstairs only
- Managers from both teams are responsible for getting volunteers from their team to spray down the seating and touch areas in the stands and spray down the handrail upstairs with the chemical spray bottles provided by the arena immediately following the conclusion of the game.
- Managers from both teams are responsible for getting one volunteer to let their team’s spectators in once the players take the ice and to also ensure that they leave immediately following the conclusion of the game.
- Spectators are not permitted to enter the facility until the ice time has started
- After the ice time spectators must exit to the parking lot and wait for their child to come out. Do not stay in the Arena.
- Maintain social distancing.

Crowfoot Arena and the CMHA Board of Directors understand parents want to watch their child play hockey. We ask for your patience as we do our best to ensure the safety of our membership and get these athletes back on the ice. If you have any questions please contact the Facility General Manager.
