**SUBJECT:** SECOND HALF 2020-21 SEASON

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I hope that you are all staying healthy and safe as we move towards the holiday season. I know we are all eager to get back on the ice, and the Return to Play Committee (RTPC), has been working out details in hopes that we will eventually be permitted to be back to cohorted game play in 2021.

With the newest restrictions in place until at least January 12th, we have had to push the start of second-half Session Play in order to allow for some practice time once teams are permitted back on the ice. The RTPC has determined a start date of Session Play to be **February 8th** for U12-U19 in the Chinook League, and all of AS-U10 in Ringette Calgary.

If we are permitted to get back on the ice after January 12th, your association will be in touch with practice ice to get teams back on the ice before games start. If restrictions are extended past January 12th, the RTPC may have to re-evaluate the February 8th start, and further communication will be sent out.

Keep your fingers crossed that we will be back on the ice in mid-January, and in the meantime, please stay safe and enjoy the Holidays!
