Parking Information

There will be free parking available for up to 2.5 hours for those visiting the facility (including the Calgary Public Library). After 2.5 hours there will be a parking fee of **\$10/day flat rate** charged. The 2.5 hour limit will be monitored and enforced Monday-Friday from 5:00am-5:00pm through a ParkPlus monitoring system. There will be no action required for stays under 2.5 hours. Following the 2.5 hour limit, registration and a \$10 payment through the ParkPlus machine or app will be required. There will be a Parking Pay Station available at the East Entrance. All vehicles that have not paid for parking after the 2.5 hour free parking limit during the enforced hours may be ticketed by the City of Calgary. The ParkPlus monitoring system will ensure the 1,000 parking spaces are available to those using the Brookfield Residential YMCA and the Calgary Public Library in this high density area (including a large hospital, high school and a variety of multi-resident buildings) which has high demand for parking.

Please note regarding arena parking: The arena entrance will be the only entrance that remains open after the main facility closing hours. Please be aware that there will not be access to the other facility entrances once the security gate has been closed.

Arena Rental Information

Access Point

Please enter and exit the facility through the Arena Entrance, which is located on the east side of the building. Face coverings are mandatory as per the City of Calgary Bylaw and must be worn by all patrons over the age of 2 when entering the premises. Upon arrival, check in with the Arena Attendant on site who will check the status of each participants Health Screening. They will then direct you to your designated area. **Refusal to complete a YMCA Health Screen means no access to the facility.**

Rules & Regulations

- It is mandatory that all individuals on the ice surface, including coaches, must wear CSA Approved winter sport helmets and skates. Bike helmets are not allowed.
- All hockey or shinny participants must wear proper safety equipment, which includes pads, gloves, and CSA Approved winter sport helmets and skates.
- Individuals under the age of 18 years cannot be on the ice surface without a coach or adult present.
- No one is allowed on the ice while the resurfacer is in use. Access to the ice is not permitted until the Arena Attendant has completed the ice resurfacing process and the doors for the ice resurfacer are closed.
- Rental groups are expected to adhere to agreed-upon rental times, ensuring that individuals exit the ice surface in a timely manner at the end of each session.
- The YMCA is a shared space with multiple rental groups accessing amenities simultaneously. It is expected that all users are respectful of others who are also using YMCA's amenities.
- Rental groups are required to follow all YMCA Calgary policies and procedures, which includes conducting behavior in a respectful, responsible, caring and honest manner.
- Smoking is not permitted within 7.5 m of the building.
- There is zero tolerance for smoking and/or vaping within the facility.
- There is zero tolerance for consumption of alcohol on YMCA Calgary premises, and it is not permitted anywhere within the facility or the parking lot.

Health & Safety Protocols

- The nearest emergency exit from Arena A is located on the east side of the building. Please first exit Arena A and make your way out of the building through the Arena Entrance on the east side.
- The nearest emergency exit from Arena B is located on the north side of the building. Please exit Arena B using one of the two emergency exits on the north side.
- The nearest First Aid Kit will be located inside the Arena Attendant's office.
- The nearest AED (automated external defibrillator) is located in Arena A inside a box that is attached to the wall.
- In case of an emergency please contact the Arena Attendant or a Duty Manager.
- A Duty Manager will be on site at all times and will support in the following ways:
 - Provide first aid
 - Provide assistance in the case of an emergency or a difficult situation
 - Answer any questions you may have
